

CAMP RULES

1. Attendance is required at all activities during the day and in the evenings. If check out becomes necessary, this must be cleared first with the Camp Coordinator or Head Camp Coach.
2. Check out from the campus requires written permission by the parent or guardian. Students are checked out only by those people authorized by the parent/guardian on the official check-out sheet or registration. No other person is allowed to check out a student.
3. Leaving campus without permission is absolutely not allowed. Violators will be sent home.
4. Curfew is at 9:30pm. This means that every student must be in the dorms. This rule will be strictly enforced. Parents will be called for violators.
5. Foul and abusive language is not allowed and will not be tolerated. Parents will be called for violators.
6. Stealing is prohibited and will not be tolerated. Parents will be called for violators.
7. Students are expected to behave like ladies. Fighting and other inappropriate behavior is not allowed. Respect for fellow students and the coaching and residential staff is required.
8. Alcohol and drugs are not allowed. Violators will be sent home immediately.
9. Visitation by family members should be limited and cleared by the camp and residential staff. However, parents are welcome to watch the daily activities.
10. If a student is driving to the camp, car keys must be checked in to the Camp Coordinator. No driving is allowed during the day and taking other students off campus is strictly prohibited.
